Position: full time permanent lecturer/researcher (« Maître de Conférence »)

Profile: sport sociology and sport management

Recruiting process: dead line for candidature: 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010; decision in July 2010; activity starting in September 2010

The candidate is expected to hold a PhD, to have published in refereed journals of the related fields and to be qualified by the French National Universities Council. A good mastery of the French language is required.

#### Teaching activities:

At the crossing of social sciences in sport and sport management, the teaching activities (around 192 hours of lectures or small group work yearly) will take place within the Sport management department of the Faculty of Sport Sciences of the University. It will cover all level of the programmes, from Bachelor to Master. That will include the theoretical dimensions of sport sociology and management, methodological innovations in strategic management of sports organisations and human resource management, as well as a strong relationship with specific areas of the sports industry. Targeted complementary competences in financing and a good knowledge of the industry and retail of sports goods will be appreciated.

The candidate will moreover have to get involved into the management of courses and the relationships with the corresponding industries and professional networks.

#### Research activities:

The candidate will become an active member of the CRIS, a nationally recognized research centre in sport sciences of the University, and in particular of the SPORTS team (Sport, Occupations, Organisations, Service and Working Relationships). Sport sociology and sport management are considered as the main fields of research. However, researches in social sciences studying professional dynamics and organisations in sport or even professional identities and skills are also welcome. Being clearly linked to the main themes of research of the coming (2011-2014) four years contract of the SPORTS team will be an important point.
