Xavier Sanchez has international (The Netherlands, UK, Belgium, France, Spain) and multidisciplinary (psychology, sport sciences) experience in both Higher Education (teaching, research) and the sport arena (consultancy). He is Master (MSc) in Sport and Exercise Psychology by the Autonomous University of Barcelona (Spain), Doctor (PhD) in Psychological Sciences by the Catholic University of Louvain at Louvain-la-Neuve (Belgium), Chartered Psychologist (CPsychol) by the British Psychological Society, and Registered Sport Psychologist (VSPN[®]) by the Dutch Society of Sport Psychology.

Xavier was the first President of European Network of Young Specialists in Sport Psychology (ENYSSP; 2003-07) and is currently the Secretary General of European Federation of Sport Psychology (FEPSAC; 2011-15). Xavier is full member of different European sport psychology societies and member of the editorial boards of International Journal of Sport Psychology, International Journal of Sport and Exercise Psychology, Revista de Psicología del Deporte, and Revista Iberoamericana de Psicología del Deporte. Xavier has reviewed manuscripts for circa 20 different journals as well as proposals of books and books chapters for publishers including Routledge, Sage, Pearson Education, and Cambridge University Press. Xavier has published in sport sciences, psychology, and sport and exercise psychology peer-reviewed journals and has presented his work at numerous national and international events.

During the last few years, Xavier has delivered similar ‘publishing’ workshops in PhD programmes as well as various conferences organised by societies such as International Society of Sport Psychology (ISSP), European Federation of Sport Psychology (FEPSAC), French Society of Sport Psychology (SFPS), British Psychological Society (BPS; Division of Sport and Exercise Psychology), and European Network of Young Specialists in Sport Psychology (ENYSSP).
